- Absence of the word "alumni"
- Is there an alumni bias?











Evolution... Part 2

Alumni and their roles

- Alumni as "doers" (Ellison 2015; Gallo; Schwartz & al 2017; Gallo & Cownie; West 2012)
- Alumni as an identity (McDearmon 2009, 2010, 2013; Dillon 2017)
- Alumni as donors (Weerts; Weerts & Ronca; Watsyn 2009; Drezner, Breeze, etc)
- Philanthropy academic centres, as a discipline
