




Alumni Potential For The Sustainable Growth Of Pakistan's Higher Education Institutions

Alumni Understanding Of Alumni Associations





Importance of the associations

Although generally, alumni realized the significance of an active association and considered it a "pre-condition" to have a sound and long-lasting relationship between alumni and institutions. However, surprisingly, most participants showed mixed feelings about the existence of alumni associations in their PHEIs.

Role of alumni associations

Alumni realized the different roles alumni associations can play like keeping consistent communication with alumni, supporting alumni in changing jobs, offering different benefits to alumni, arranging events for alumni, playing an active role in official bodies of the institution, creating an alumni fund to support needy students, and bridging the industry-academia gap









What Limits Alumni Associations To Establish





Institutions lack interest, clarity, and support in forming alumni associations

Generally, institutions are found to create awareness about the benefits of having formal alumni associations. Therefore, alumni generally lack clarity about their role in the formation of formal or informal alumni associations.

Informal chapters are replacing formal alumni associations

for the sake of ease, institutions are generally operating informal chapters of alumni based in different regions to remain connected with alumni.
